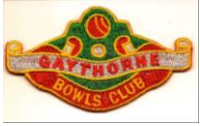

a small part of Franks' incredible life. Frank Long was born in the Emerald Hospital in Central Queensland and raised on the family property just outside of town until at the age of twelve, he was sent to Downlands College in Toowoomba. Frank participated in a number of activities and sports including tennis. Moving to Melbourne after completing his education at Downlands, he worked for an Oil Company travelling throughout Victoria and South Australia, doing a job that he really loved. Frank met the love of his life, Margaret, who became his wife of 59 years. They raised 2 daughters and 2 sons of whom he is very proud. 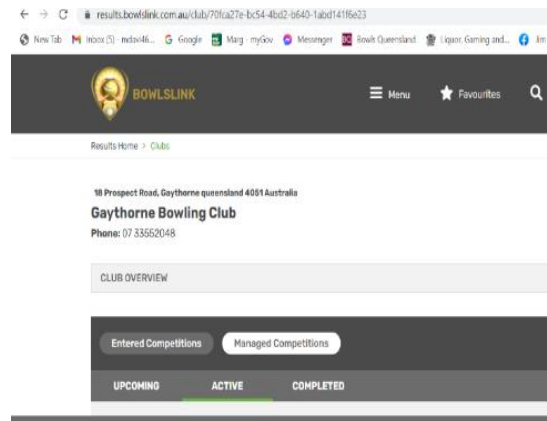

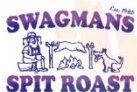
